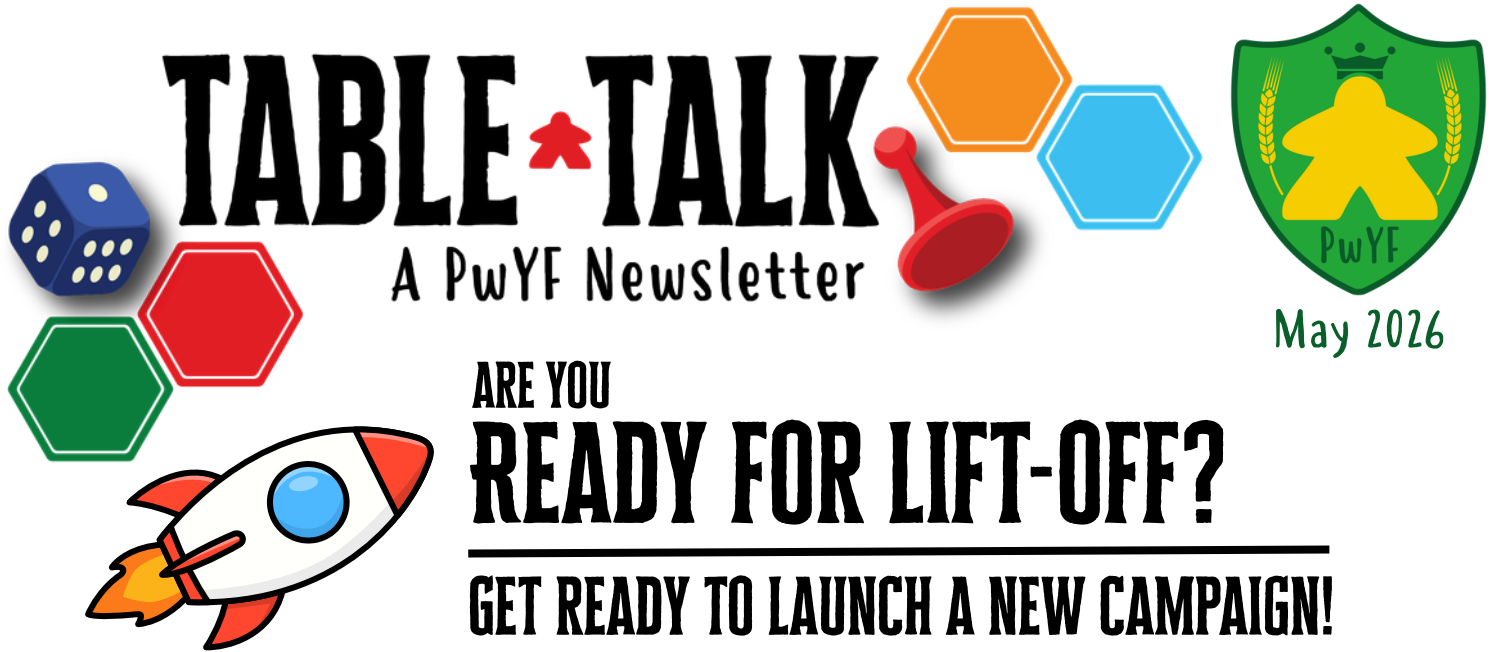

MEEPLE IN YOUR NEIGHBOURHOOD



For many people, board gaming is about more than just the games, it's about finding community. That has certainly been true for **David Greaves**, one of the newest faces helping grow the Play with Your Food and Chewsday Challenge community.

Originally from Ontario, David moved to Saskatoon in 2015 and found himself searching for connection in a brand-new city. After remembering how much he had enjoyed games like Dominion, Pandemic, and Ticket to Ride, he decided joining a gaming group might be a good way to meet people and feel more at home. It worked!

What began as a casual interest quickly became a major hobby after David connected with experienced gamers who introduced him to a wider range of tabletop experiences. "I found my people and hobby and haven't looked in the rear view since," he says.

When David relocated to the Regina area in 2025, he once again went looking for a gaming community and was encouraged to check out Chewsday Challenge. His first game night included a play of Oath, a deep and thematic strategy game, and he was immediately hooked.

"I had a blast," he says. "I kept coming back for the people and the games."

As he became more involved, David says he gained an even greater appreciation for the mission behind Play with Your Food.

"It's beautiful that the gaming community comes together like that to support a good cause while enjoying the hobby we all love," he explains.

Outside of gaming, David works remotely for the University of Saskatchewan, supporting professors in using data to enhance teaching and learning. He and his wife Laura also live on an acreage south of Regina alongside what he jokingly describes as "quite the little zoo." Their home includes 17 animals, including alpacas, llamas, horses, cats, a dog, guinea pigs, and even a tortoise.

When it comes to games, David enjoys almost anything, especially thematic games with strategic depth, although he admits reaction-based games may not be his strength after repeatedly losing to his wife at Ghost Blitz.



Now stepping into the role of a Chewsday Challenge Ambassador, David is excited to help welcome even more people into the community that meant so much to him when he first arrived.

"It's a great way to have fun while supporting a worthy cause," he says. "Everyone is just so friendly and kind."
